Code of Ethics 2008

**For People Working with Children and Youth of the
First Unitarian Society in Newton**

Adults and older youth who are in leadership roles are in a position of stewardship and play a key role in fostering spiritual development of both individuals and the community. It is, therefore, especially important that those in leadership positions be well qualified to provide the special nurture, care and support that will enable youth to develop a positive sense of self and a spirit of independence and responsibility. The relationship between young people and their leaders must be one of mutual respect if the positive potential is to be realized. There are no more important areas of growth than those of self worth and the development of healthy identity as a sexual being. Adults play a key role in assisting youth in these areas of growth. It is critical that leaders not engage in sexual, seductive, or erotic behavior with youth. Neither shall they sexually harass or engage in behavior with youth that constitutes verbal, emotional or physical abuse.
