We're glad you're coming! Here's what you need to know.

DIRECTIONS:

Take 95N (128N) or alternate route to Maine Turnpike (still 95N) and take **Exit 36** Route 195 - Saco/Old Orchard. 195 will trunk down into an undivided road. When you reach a major intersection, go straight across, keeping the 7-11 store on your left. You will be on Temple Avenue. Speed limit is 25 mph and enforced. At the four-way stop that has a blinking light, turn right onto Route 9. This road runs parallel to the ocean. Follow Route 9 south for 2.2 miles. (**Do not take the right fork marked Ferry Beach State Park.**) You'll eventually come to a carved wooden sign for Ferry Beach on your right and Ferry Beach Ave. on your left. Turn left, and Quillen is the last building on the right. All room assignments will be posted in Quillen Lobby and the porch of each building. Look for activities there too. All your stuff is in unlocked rooms; please keep that in mind.

WHAT TO BRING:

Be sure to bring PILLOWS, SLEEPING BAGS OR LINENS, & TOWELS (bath and beach), the rooms have mattresses only. Clothes for layering in all types of weather (shorts, rain gear, swimsuits to down parkas), musical instruments, *Rise Up Singing* songbooks, flashlights, board games, evening snacks to share, tennis rackets, basketballs, volleyballs, binoculars, dance tapes and discs, camera, beach toys, sand-castle tools, puzzles, Frisbees, stuff to do if it rains. Bring your own poetry or some from a published poet to read. If you have *approved* expenses for an activity, please keep your receipts for reimbursement.

HERE ARE A FEW OF THE FERRY BEACH RULES:

- Smoking (including vaping pens) is only allowed on Quillen porch, no other buildings or porches. The buildings are old. Do not burn candles, incense, lighters, tobacco products, or anything flammable in any of the buildings, not even a chalice if worship services are held indoors. *Each building has fire alarm systems, which are directly connected to the Saco Fire Department. If it goes off, the fire department will be there and there is no way to call them off.*
- Alcoholic Beverages may be served and consumed while at Ferry Beach, but only in public areas and never by anyone under 21.
- Pets are not allowed except for service animals.
- **Quiet** Please observe a quiet time between 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM. Others and Ferry Beach neighbors will thank you for your cooperation.
- In accordance with local and state health ordinances, bare feet are not allowed in the dining room.
- **Children under 13 must ALWAYS be accompanied by an adult on the beach. No one under 18 is allowed on the beach after dark unless accompanied by an adult**
